Fly Like an Eagle

Isaiah 40:27-31

1. What principles or truth stood out to you the most from Pastor Ron's sermon today?
2. What does the saying, "My way is hidden from the Lord, and my right is disregarded by my God" mean? Explore and discuss.

Notes: Think of this in the context of: the absurdity of losing faith in the One who, in relation to the earth, is all powerful (12), all wise (13-14), dominant (15-17), with there being nothing to challenge, check or rival him (18-20), King of kings (21-24), sovereignly in charge of his world down to the smallest detail so that everything is in its place, nothing overlooked, nothing lost!

3. In verse 28, Isaiah reminds Israel about the things that they have known and heard about their God. Why is this important and what difference should it make in the life of the believer?

4. Notice the names for God that Isaiah uses: LORD (Yahweh), The proper name for Israel's covenant keeping God. The everlasting God (The Eternal One), and the Creator (maker of all things and mankind). Why these particular names and what would be their significance? What can we take away from this?

5. Isaiah brings some of Gods attributes to our attention, — Eternality, Omnipresence, untiring strength, and wisdom. Is there a reason he picks these attributes? What would this have meant to Israel as the original recipients? Should it convey meaning for us today? If yes, then what meaning should it be?

6. Notice and contrast between the faint/weary theme and the power/might/strength theme. What conclusions can you draw out from this?

7. What are your takeaways from today's lesson? How will you apply these principles to your life this week?
