

Shores Students Covid-19 Guidelines

Q. When does Sunday Night Students start?

A. Sunday Night for Students reopens for in-person hangouts in September 20, 2020 in the Life Center. Another option available to you is to watch online via YouTube LIVE at ShoresStudentMin. Q. What will Sunday Night Students look like?

A. Our goal as a Student Ministry is to make things feel as normal as possible. However, due to CDC guidelines, seating will be spaced six (6) feet apart. Games and greeting will happen at a safe distance and without contact.

Q. What happens when I arrive and depart?

A. When students arrive, leaders will direct them into the Life Center in a contactless manner. Doors will be opened as students enter and all activities will take place in a large, open area of the Life Center. All other areas will be locked and unavailable (except restrooms). As students depart our facilities, we will again make sure the front doors are open for them to leave in a contactless way. We require that all students wear a cloth face covering or mask. Leaders will be required to wear a cloth face covering or mask.

Q. What precautions are we taking?

A. According to guidelines prescribed by the CDC, we are taking every precaution to ensure the environment is sanitized and safe for all students and leaders. This includes a thorough cleaning and sanitizing of all student areas before and after use, as well as maintaining safe distances during hangout, games, worship, and teaching times. If you have had any of the following symptoms or conditions this week in the past 10 days, please remain home and watch Sunday Night Students online.

- Fever over 100 degrees
- Cough or sore throat
- Shortness of breath
- Contact with anyone (in the past 10 days) confirmed to have COVID-19
- Compromised immune system
