*Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions.* PSALM 51:1 ESV

2. \_\_\_\_\_ up!

*For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. <sup>4</sup> Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you may be justified in your words and blameless in your judgment. <sup>5</sup> Behold, I was brought*

*forth in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me.* <sup>6</sup> *Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being, and you teach me wisdom in the secret heart.* PSALM 51:3-6 ESV

*For when I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long.* <sup>4</sup> *For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer.* <sup>5</sup> *I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not cover my iniquity; I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord," and you forgave the iniquity of my sin.* PSALM 32:3-5 ESV

*Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed.* JAMES 5:16 ESV

*Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin!* PSALM 51:2  
ESV
