### 1. Ram / 8:3-4 / \_\_\_\_\_

### 2. Goat / 8:5-8 / \_\_\_\_\_

*As I was considering, behold, a male goat came from the west across the face of the whole earth, without touching the ground. ... and the goat is the king of Greece.* DANIEL 8:5-8, 21-22 ESV

### 3. Little Horn / 8:9-14 / \_\_\_\_\_

*Out of one of them came a little horn ...* DANIEL 8:9-14, 23- 26 ESV

## **“The Time of the End”**
