2. Why do you think John the Baptist had this question found in 11:3 on his mind, "Are you the one who is to come, or shall we look for another?" When we are find ourselves with a difficult situation, How do we respond?

3. What type of answer did Jesus use to respond to John? How can we use that same approach in our daily lives?

4. In Jesus' response to John, can you see a modern day application justifying keeping a prayer journal or even a daily walk journal? What would be the value of such a practice?

5. In Matthew 11:25-30, what is a yoke and why does Jesus ask us to take his yoke upon us?

6. Outline the significant points and principles from Matthew 11:25 - 30. How do we take Jesus' yoke upon us? How do we accomplish this exchange of our yoke for his?

7. How will you implement what you believe this lesson is teaching? How will you implement the principles of this lesson to your character? How will it change the conduct of your lifestyle?
