- 1. How important is a reverent, thoughtful approach to God in prayer? Under what kinds of circumstances is a hurried approach permissible?
- 2. What is God jealous about (Zephaniah 1:18; 3:8)? Is it right for God to be jealous? What does the Bible mean when it says God is jealous?
- 3. What does it mean to you that the Lord is "in the midst" of his people (3:5,15,17)?

- 4. What various kinds of sin are exposed in 3:1-5? Are such sins common today?
- 5. In Zephaniah's "day of joy," describe what this means in the context of chapter 3. What can you bring forward as a principle for the believer today in their walk of faith?
- 6. Contrast Zephaniah 3:2 with James 4:7-10? Which group of qualities is more evident in your life? How do we grow in the grace of the good qualities?
- 7. How will you apply this lesson into your walk of faith?
